Discovering Space 2 is all about exploration. There's no action, shooting or explosions, just sightseeing, discovery and relaxation on an epic scale.

The adventures of AFGNCAAP!

PROS: As far as point & click adventures go, the visuals are wonderful. Most pop out to help display a picture of the areas that you're in. The music does a decent job conveying the mood. The standouts are the voice actors & the FMV's. Erick Avari & Michael McKean deserve special mention for their charismatic, humorous, and charming rolls at Mir Yannick and Dalboz of Gurth, respectively, selling their roles as the villain & the hero's...assistant, I suppose. The humor is also on point, especially for those who are fans of Monty Python styled human mingled in with classic Zork moments.

CONS: As with many games from this era, bringing it up on modern equipment can be lacking. There are little to no option adjustment options, & the visuals have a fair bit of artifacting around them. The major problem would be a bit of a divide between it's puzzles, as the game is a fair bit easier than many point & click adventure games of it's time, but still has the occasional odd puzzle that can throw one off, unless they've been checking everything they can. For me, it falls on the easy side of things. Added onto the fact that, like many games in this genre, it's a one & done experience. A single play through can show you everything in the game, leaving no real reason to go back to it.

FINAL: Zork Grand Inquisitor is a wonderful finale for the Zork series, going back to more light-hearted roots after the surprisingly dark Zork Nemesis. With simple gameplay, solid humor, & a well acted strip, ZGI is easily a game that any fan of point & click adventures should play at least once.. It's fun game and dialogues are hilarious. Character designs are unlikable and ugly though.. Well lets see a game designed to build a dungeon, fill duneon with loot make dungeon satisfying to heros, let said heros come in get loot and satisfation. then send out monsters to beat heros and get your loot back and tourture them and take the satisfation back. Like another reviewer said it does this well.

This is a sequel to Dungeons, not a sequel to or remake of dungeon keeper, so if you bought the game believing that and are now ♥♥♥♥♥♥♥♥♥♥ off about it, then the idiot screw up is your fault not the developers. Hating the game and giving it a bad review based on a game its not a sequel to or meant to be, is idiotic. It's not the most gripping or attention holding game ive ever played, which is why ive only logged 3.6 hours but it was mildly entertaining. Probably not worth \$20 more like \$14 or so.

So if youre looking for a sequel to dungeon keeper then keep looking this is a sequel to dungeons, and you wont find dungeon keeper here.. As close as it gets to the real thing. Wonderful graphics and works well on even an average machine with a dual core processor and fairly decent graphics card. However the addition of a driving range and putting green would be very useful not only to warm up but to get used to the very realistic characteristics of the gameplay with the mouse and gamepad. You can practise on the course but a dedicated practise area would be great. Don't let that put you off though because it is a superb program anyway and I'm sure it will only get better and better. 5 star!. Awesome and different painting tool. Quite unique.

No hours in and I can say this game, for price(free), is just as enjoyable as Dead by Daylight. If not more. I compare them because its about the same game. Cept DBD costs \$10 atm.

Fluffy "horror" game basically with small map and minimal possible actions as victim other than run or save friends. If you tried Dead by Daylight for free and thought, "Meh," then save your money and grab Light Bearers to scratch itch. OR just buy Friday 13th. Just dont buy DBD :D. I enjoyed the game very much. I clocked 7 hours into the game, but a few times I left it running while I did a few other things around the house. It was not a short game even with that, and I didn't skip any HOS or puzzles. I don't know how anyone can finish is 2 hours!

No, it's not hard, but the story is different. No wicked witch or black-robed demon. A "modern" day tale. With clever allusions to historical figures!

I wish we could find the missing emblems. I wasn't sure what was happening at the end, when the table for them was shown, so gave the bag to my father, which ended the game. If you get to the table missing emblems, try to find them! That was a disappointment to me.

It is probably my computer (all in one running Windows 8.1), at least my son is always blaming it, but the cut scene images lag behind the cut scene talking. It did that when I demoed on the Windows Store, so I bought here hoping it would be different. It didn't affect the game play, but still.... I really like this game.

It looked to me like an arena fighting game at first glance so I always ignored it. I bought it on sale for 79 cents on a whim and I'm sure glad I did.

It looks like Titans Quest, but It plays very much like an MMO. Tab targeting, auto-attack, skills hotbar, camps of mobs you have to carefully pull, etc. If you aren't in to MMO-style combat, you may not like this. The combat reminds me of Vanguard and several others. Fights are quicker though, mobs your level usually die in 10-15 seconds.

The leveling is relatively fast so far. I've been playing about 6 hours and am level 31. I did grind out a couple of levels once to make an area easier, but it only took about 10 minutes.

A big plus for me is that there are 16 item slots, including four ring slots. I prefer many slots and slower upgrades rather than constant upgrades to 6 or 8 slots.

One of the things I didn't like about it are the slow walking speed when you first start the game as a child. But once you leave the tutorial island and become an adult, the walking speed is very good.

Another thing I don't care for is the day/night system. You have to find a campfire to rest, with the option of resting to restore stamina only, or until morning or evening. It seemed like I had to rest until night time to make one quest mob appear but there was no indication of this that I saw so I roamed around looking for him before trying to wait until night time. So far, this was the only time day or night mattered, other than picking some flowers on the tutorial island, and you are told to do that at night.

The last thing is the save system. You can only save at one of the campfires. There are plenty of them around so this is not a big issue for me, but a "save anywhere" would be nice.

I only went to the arena for a few minutes and it was kind of weird and not all that fun, so hopefully it'll be mostly optional.

The graphics are on par with most MMO graphics and the sound is adequate but there is not a lot of music.

Having finished all other RPG's that interest me, and being between MMO's at the moment, I'm having a lot of fun with this. I would have easily paid the full \$7.99 for it had I realized what it actually was.

Edit:

- 1) I finished the game in 13 hours at level 80.
- 2) The arena is optional. I never went there again and only lost a little favor with the gods for missing a tournament.
- 3) The night/day thing was not a big deal. There are 3-4 times someone or something will only appear at night.

4) A couple of the quests are a bit vague. I consulted a walkthrough a few times.

5) It did crash on me twice, both times after saving and entering a new zone.

It was still probably the most fun I've ever had for 79 cents, and is well worth even full price, imo, if you can overlook a few minor issues.. These items are already available in the game, just the coloring is different. As another reviewer stated, the armor items wear out and cannot be repaired, quickly rendering it useless. The weapon is inferior to most others available in the vanilla game, and there are mods that can get you better for free.

A complete waste of time and money.. This is not your average dry management sim. It's quite unlike anything else I've played, honestly. It's certainly unique enough to be worth your time.

There's a weird storyline woven into the game, and I promise it's a story you haven't seen and won't expect. There are really interesting metaphors and funny surprises throughout the game as well.

None of the mechanics are particularly deep or challenging, but still manage to be satisfying. The sheer quantity of things to do at any one moment keeps it from getting boring.

It's not a long game, and it shouldn't be. It's fun, and it's certainly unique. It's cheap, too, and a bargain on sale.

Definitely check this one out.. Managed to beat the game in under 6 hours. A new personal record for me. The only downfall I have with this game, is unlike a good majority of stuff on the steam market, it doesn't allow cross-platform. Something to consider when buying. As such, I can't install multiplayer on my windows PC without rebuying the game.. Simple but brilliant. So much replay value and just all around fun. I've loved the Nancy Drew books since my youth. I'd also apparently lived under a rock for quite some time because I hadn't known that games were made based in her adventures. I really enjoyed this game since it was one that made you think and combined some casual games with some not so casual ones. I especially liked working with the wolf.

That darn Fox and Geese game irritated me greatly though. The man just wouldn't go to the quarter I needed him in. It took some time to get the wins I needed for that puzzle. I also am now going to have to get a Fox and Geese board for the kids and I.

I really recommend this game to a mystery lover that likes to think. I don't recommend it to those that are used to games that are just bash and trash.
